Dear Friends and Faithful Supporters,

It seems appropriate, once in a while, to give a few highlights of things happening around Europe in the Teen Challenge work. We continue to be amazed on several levels. First, we are amazed at the continued open doors for the work among society's marginalized – especially the addicted. Second, we are amazed at the servanthood-leadership God has raised up across Europe in our work. These leaders (and workers) are our heroes! Third, we are amazed at God's continued blessing on the works around Europe. He is with us!

So buckle up, and let's take a quick drive around Europe and see some highlights:

Iceland: The young work there continues to grow. Now they will add a women's center in Reykjavik.

Sweden: They are in the planning stages for opening a rehabilitation program in addition to the street work they do regularly.

Norway: *Marita Foundation* is seeing many miracles in the prisons of Norway. They have a wide open door. The prison work is led by a former addict/criminal who has the ear of all prisoners and officials!

Albania: TC there has just opened a second center to help handle the many names on the waiting list. They are entering a building project to double their space.

Ukraine: In the midst of the war, a few new outreaches have been added—and now cooperation with 80 rehab programs, run by local churches of the Pentecostal movement, is developing well.

Romania: The work there has touched the nation. The leader was honored by the King of Romania. In addition to five residential programs, their media outreach has an enormous footprint reaching millions through short videos. The Gospel is preached!

Austria: For many decades, no residential work existed in Austria. Now a center for women is open and lives are being touched!

Serbia: The Rainbow Rehabilitation Center is running with magnificent results. Many men are being transformed, daily, by the Gospel.

5-Star Works: In **Poland, Belarus, The UK, Ireland, and Czech Republic**, large ministries with Evangelism outreaches and residential programs exist. Many lives are being touched in these countries.

We are amazed at these works of God, and even more amazed at the leaders he has called to them. I have listed only 13 of 40 countries. It is a privilege to be a part of this great ministry called Teen Challenge. And, once again, our involvement would not be possible without the faithful supporters he has given us.
